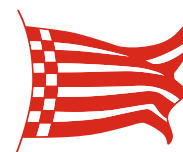

The keel laying marks the moment a ship's design comes to life, as the structure of the 7,999 DWT IMO II bunker tanker begins to take shape. Purpose-built for operational flexibility and future fuel readiness, Anna Cosulich will combine performance, safety and environmental responsibility in one transition-ready asset built for the new era of maritime fuels.

She will feature MarineLINE cargo tank coating, ensuring superior chemical resistance, faster tank turnaround and extended service life. In addition, she will be equipped with a nitrogen generator, Quick-Connect/Disconnect couplings (QCDC), two mass flow meters, two segregations and full compliance with methanol bunkering requirements, making her a benchmark for efficiency, safety and regulatory readiness in the alternative fuels supply chain.

From robust twin-screw propulsion to optimized cargo-handling systems, every aspect of Anna Cosulich is engineered to minimize emissions, maximize uptime and deliver dependable performance. She will be a future-proof asset, adaptable to an evolving fuel landscape, from conventional fuels to methanol and beyond.
